CorpHealth To Offer Free Kidney Health Screening

WESTERVILLE, Ohio –Central Ohio’s only wellness and disease prevention center, CorpHealth, will be holding a free kidney health screening this Friday to educate participants on the importance of kidney health as well as offer information on coping with kidney disease.

The screening will be held Friday, July 14 at the CorpHealth offices, located at 58 Westerview Drive, Westerville, Ohio 43081, from 9:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. Attendees will complete a health questionnaire and have their blood pressure and weight checked. Medical personnel will collect urine samples for testing; blood samples may also be obtained if indicated by the screening urine test.
