CorpHealth offers innovative, web-based access to full-time staff medical director – and reduces costs for employers

WESTERVILLE, Ohio – Evaluating an employee’s FMLA, worker’s compensation, or disability claim can be confusing to non-medical personnel. If an employer has a company physician, questions can be easily answered.

But what happens if you’re a small or medium-sized company, and you don’t have a licensed medical provider on staff?

Westerville-based CorpHealth has launched an innovative way for small- to medium-sized companies to obtain physician guidance, using the Internet. Users can submit their question through a secure online form; additional supporting documentation can be uploaded with the form, e-mailed or faxed. The information is immediately transmitted to a board-certified physician, who reviews the information and provides a written opinion within 24 to 72 hours of receipt.

The process is so unique, the CorpHealth e-MD method is patent-pending.

“This is an ideal option for companies that do not want, need, or have access to a full-time, staff medical director,” says Dr. Patricia David, president and CEO of CorpHealth. “Like the various ‘ask-a-nurse’ and ‘ask-a-pharmacist’ sites commonly seen on the web, CorpHealth e-MD makes it very easy for non-medical personnel to get a physician’s opinion regarding a claim or a medical issue at their workplace. The physician opinions may then be utilized to assist in determining the employer’s next step.”

While originally designed to reduce costs for small- to medium-sized employers, CorpHealth e-MD has become increasingly popular with attorneys, claims examiners, and other non-medical professionals charged with the administration of claims, because it gives them a cost-effective option for obtaining medical opinions.
